COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

A wall-mounted floating console in carved blackened steel, defined by a rhythmic system of undulating legs that gives the piece both structure and movement. The surface carries a carved texture throughout, revealing subtle irregularities from the handmade process and giving the steel a tactile, almost worked-by-hand presence. Inspired by a classic Jean Royère design, the console reinterprets mid-century elegance through a darker, more sculptural language.
