Inspired by the form and function of grain silos, the Silo Console Table strikes a balance between utilitarian purpose and aestheticism. This sculptural console features a solid wood or marble top and hand-finished brass or stainless steel wrapped legs.

Available with optional hollow brass domes that sit atop the table to continue the shape of the cylindrical legs, transforming them with a striking and elegant presence. The magnetized domes are removable, revealing inlay brass and a playful location to store small objects from keys to matches. *Made by hand in Pennsylvania.*

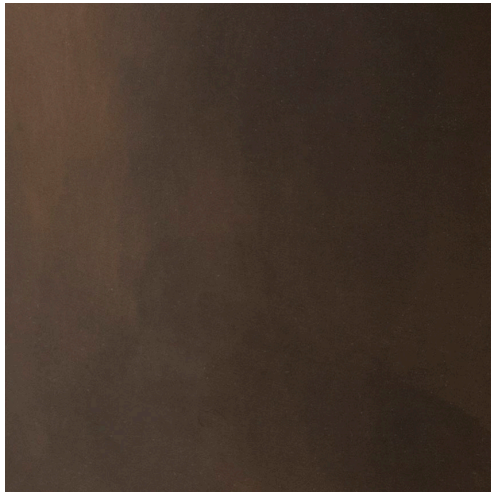




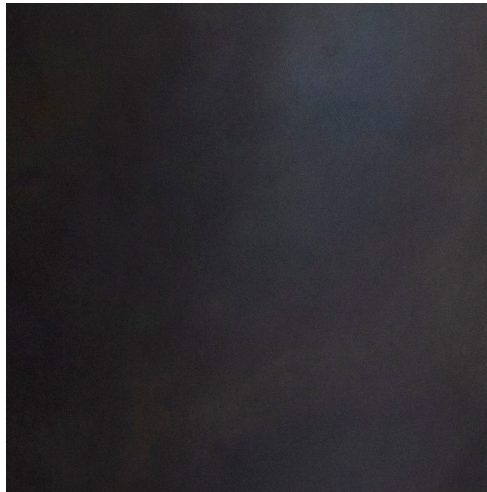
Burnished Brass

Blackened Brass

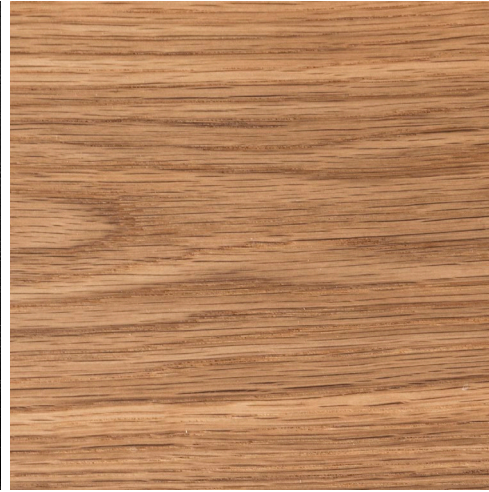


Polished Stainless Steel

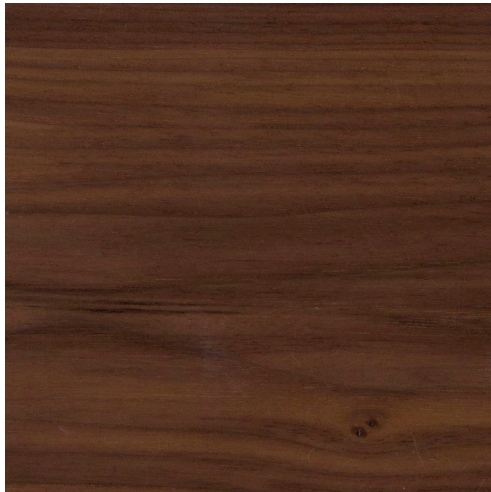
Note: burnished brass is a live finish, and will continue to naturally patina over time.



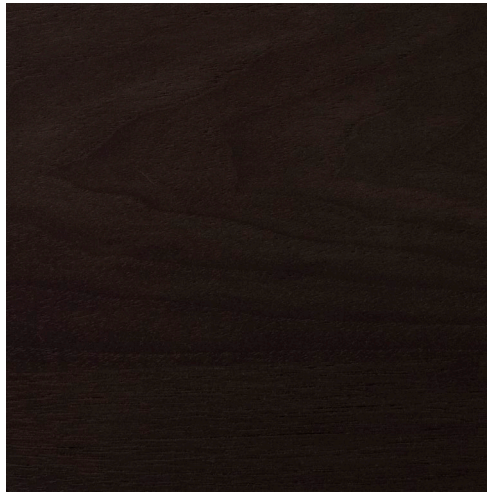
Blackened Oak



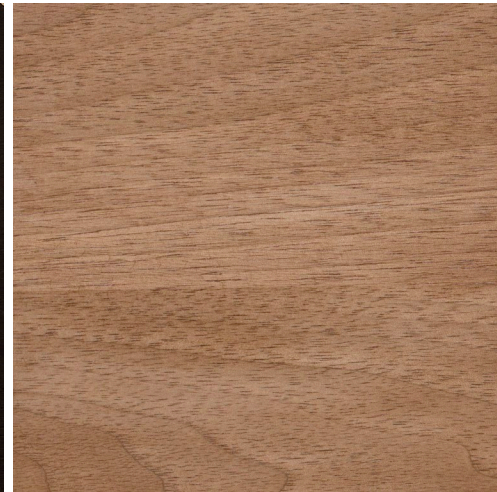
White Oak



Natural Walnut

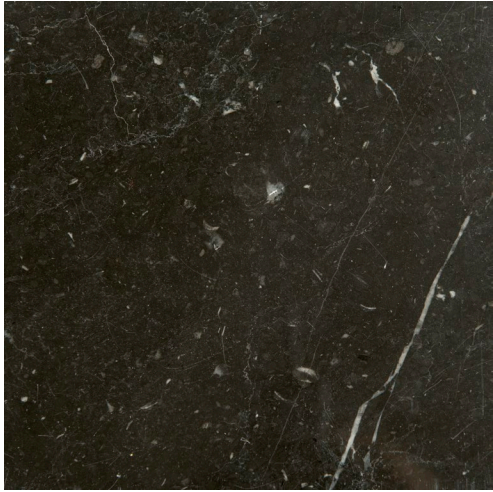


Ebonized Walnut



Bleached Walnut

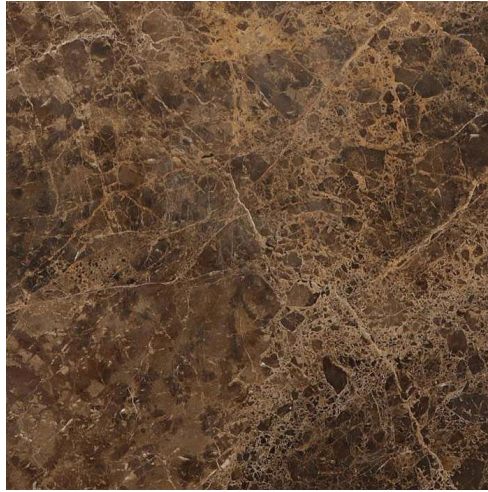

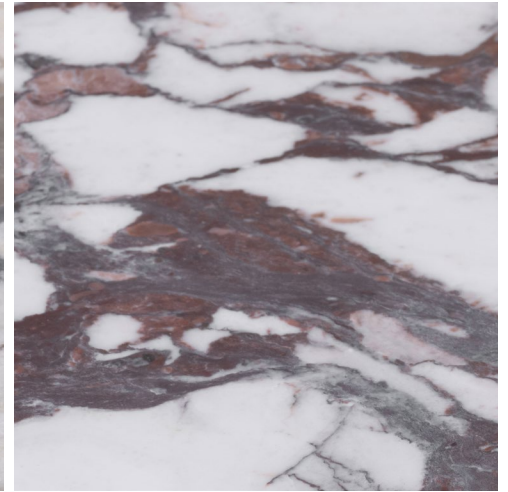
